# **Summary of Allocations**

Texas Louisiana Mississippi Alabama Florida\*

#### Louisiana

The application process closed on November 23, 2020.

The Commission has received 1,052 applications representing 865 applicants.

The Commission has made \$2,753,577.87 in payments.

### Alabama

The application process closed on November 27, 2020.

The Commission received 74 applications representing 72 applicants.

The Commission made \$3,254,064 in payments to the 72 applicants.

## Mississippi

The application process closed on January 5, 2021.

The Commission received 223 applications representing 223 applicants.

The Commission made \$1,414,684.83 in payments.

#### Texas

The Texas Spend Plan was approved on January 26, 2021.

The application process opened on February 1, 2021 and will close March 18, 2021.

As of Monday, March 15, Texas has received 245 applications that will be reviewed for eligibility over the next few weeks.

# **CARES Act Program**

Overall, the Commission has received 1348 applications and has paid out \$7,422,326.70 to eligible applicants.

The total for the Commission is \$28,857,402. The remaining funds must be spent by September 30, 2021.
