Project Guidelines

The project guidelines for proposed state projects are as follows:

- Existing formula-based state IFA funds are not expected to be replaced with new IJF funds.
- Continuation of proposed and funded projects will be subject to annual IJF funding levels and priorities.
- In the event a new sampling protocol becomes an established program, the responsible partner(s) will assume long-term operational costs using a combination of available state and formula-based IFA funds.
- IJF funds will not be used for current programs with established resources unless they are not currently part of the existing fishery-independent monitoring programs. New gears and sampling which are transferable to all the states may be supported as they begin implementation elsewhere.
- Annual IJF funds may be directed to multiple small projects or a few large projects.
 Projects may be allocated to one or more state partners for novel fishery-independent sampling and protocols, specific studies that address a biology, habitat, ecosystem, or fishery participation questions.
