Al1 licenses require an additional $\$ 1.00$ issuance fee. Licenses may be purchased by mail from Marine Resources Division, P.O. Box 189, Dauphin Island, AL 36528 by enclosing a money order for the license fee. There is no application form. Applicants for oyster boat, shrimp boat and purse seine licenses must include the registered vessel name or state registration number. Before selling a live bait dealer license the person's boat, truck, or place of business must be inspected. Florida commercial licenses show the $\$ 200$ SPL boat license. This would be $\$ 100$ if only one person is aboard the boat. Licenses may be purchased at Marine Resources Division offices at Dauphin Island, Bayou La Batre and Gulf Shores.

## IMPORTANT NOTES

## Alabama

- All Alabama commercial licenses are valid from October 1 through September 30 of consecutive years, and may be purchased at any time between those dates.
- All Alabama commercial fishing license fees listed in Tables 1-4 are per vessel unless otherwise noted.


## Florida

- All Florida commercial licenses are valid from July 1 through June 30 of consecutive years, and may be purchased at any time between those dates.
- All Florida resident/nonresident saltwater products license fees will double on October 1, 1989.
- The $\$ 25$ resident or $\$ 100$ nonresident Individual Saltwater Products License allows any individual to work in any fishery on any vessel in Florida waters. (Purse seines require an additional license.)
- The $\$ 50$ resident or $\$ 200$ nonresident Vessel Saltwater Products License allows any vessel (including any number of crew members) to work in any fishery in Florida waters. (Purse seines require an additional license.)


## Louisiana

- All Louisiana commercial licenses are valid from January 1 through December 31 of each year and can be obtained from the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries at any time of the year, and from October 1 of the preceding year.
- If a vessel is being used, only the operator on board the vessel is required to have a commercial fisherman's license. Helpers on the vessel are not required to have a license.


## Mississippi

- All Mississippi commercial licenses are valid from May 1 through April 30 of consecutive years, and must be purchased between January 1 and April 30 of each calendar year.
- All Mississippi commercial fishing license fees listed in Tables 1-4 are per vessel unless otherwise noted.


## Texas

- Commercial oyster dredge licenses must be purchased during the month of August.
- Commercial bay shrimp boat licenses must be purchased during the months of January and February.
- All other commercial licenses may be purchased at any time during the year.
- All Texas commercial licenses are valid from September 1 through August 31 of consecutive years.
