Sidegill slug

Class Gastropoda
Order Notaspidea
Family Pleurobranchidae

Diagnostic characters: Gill-plume located externally on the right side of the body; rhinophores and a buccal veil present at the anterior end; rhinophores fastened laterally, bases separate, between the borders of the velum and mantle; **dorsal tail-spur black.**

Habitat: Moderately common; 0 to 100 m.

Range: North Carolina to Texas; Brazil.
