

Stramonita haemastoma canaliculata (Gray, 1839)
= *Thais haemastoma*
Hay's Rock-shell

Class Gastropoda
Family Muricidae

Classification according to Turgeon *et al.* (1998)
References used: Description from Abbott (1974)

Diagnostic characters: This subspecies is characterized by its large size (up to 4 ½ inches in length), strongly indented suture and rugose sculpture with a row of double, strong nodules on the shoulder of the whorls.

Range: Northwest Florida to Texas.
