





Budget Preparation and Review

Budget Planning

Budget planning, priorities guidance.

Budget Formulation - President's Budget Request

Guidance from NOAA, DOC, and OMB is provided to formulate the budget.
Budget request to Congress is released the 1st Monday in February.

Congressional Action

Hearings & Mark-ups

Congress deliberates on the budget request typically through the spring and summer.

Appropriations

An appropriation bill is provided prior to the start of the fiscal year (Oct. 1).

Budget Execution

Apportionment

After the budget is appropriated, an apportionment must be signed to allow distribution of funds for obligation.

Rescissions & Other Costs

From the appropriated amounts, agencies are subject to rescissions and other costs that must be accounted for before arriving at the funding available for a specific program or project.

Allocation & Allotment

Funding becomes available

GSMFC FY 2022 Funds Status

- NMFS has received partial apportionment of funds
 - 。 GSMFC: \$750K
 - In process for obligation w/in 10 days
- FY 2022 balance:
 - Will provide upon final budget apportionment
 - Expect similar to prior years (~\$1.3M in total)



Key GoM Investments **all** maintained at FY21 funding levels:

- SEAMAP
- Red Snapper/State Management Implementation
- South Atlantic Reef Fish Assessments
- Charter For-Hire EM/ER (mgt & enforcement)

- Recreational Fish Data Collection Collaboration
- Aquaculture Pilots (Regional and IMTA)
- Off-bottom Eastern Oyster Research



FY22 GoM Red Snapper Enacted Language

Supports:

- Delay implementing State-specific calibration until 2023
- NMFS, contract with non-governmental entity to assess which catch data programs provide best estimates of GOM recreational red snapper catch
- Integration of Great Red Snapper Count data and Gulf States catch data into:
 - Red snapper research track stock assessment – due 2023
 - Operational assessment 2024






The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, 2020

- Timing will vary around the country




